Currently, the club has a 9-hole course, which genClubly organizes over 26 tournaments annually and holds the first-ever Nepal Open Golf Tournament. It is also one of the most cherished courses in South Asia. The golf club is located on the outskirts of Kathmandu.

Located on the northeastern side of the valley, Gokarna was a hunting ground for the former Kings of Nepal. Gleneagles Golf Developments of Scotland designed this 6,755-yard, 72-hole, 18-hole course. It is also considered to be one of the best in Southeast Asia. You will find spotted deer, barking deer, monkeys, and different species of birds to accompany or distract you while you are playing.

Likewise, the Himalayan Golf Club provides a unique golfing experience in South Asia. Furthermore, several golf championships are held in the club. This 6,900-yard, par-73, 18-hole Club Course offers scenic [views of the Annapurna](#) Himalayan Range and a river flowing right through the course. Isn't that a way to enjoy a wonderful [tour of Nepal](#)?

The 18-hole Nirvana Country Club perfectly escapes city life to countryside scenes. The golf joint is located in Dharan, on the eastern side of Nepal, which offers a tranquil and scenic environment for golfers.

Boudhanath: Located on the northeastern outskirts of Kathmandu Valley, Boudhanath is the largest stupa in Nepal. Probably built in the 14th century, it is described in various legends.

Pashupatinath Temple: One of Asia's four most sacred temples, Pashupatinath is dedicated to Lord Shiva. Built-in the 5th century and later renovated by the Malla Kings, the site itself is said to have existed from the beginning of the millennium. You can see rituals taking dips in the holy Bagmati river beside the temple.

Among various golf courses, Gokarna is acclaimed to be the best resort golf course in Nepal. Overall, Gokarna Golf guarantees a day filled with fun and excitement.

Day : Morning Yoga, flight to Pokhara and sightseeing

Tsitight is a delight, with excellent pubs and restaurants on one side and flanked by the Annapurna range on the other. The lake also houses the crucial Hindu temple Barahi on a small island. The temple is dedicated to lord Vishnu.

In the evening we can also relax on the banks of the lake.

In competitive golf matches, players typically play four rounds of 18 holes each. The winner is the player who finishes the course with the fewest shots. This scoring format is known as stroke play and is commonly used in golf tournaments.
